1. NYC Weekend Readiness Score

Factor	Why it matters
Arrival airport	JFK, LGA, and EWR can change total weekend value through transfer cost, time, luggage, and traffic.
Hotel area	A better hotel area can save more time than a cheaper room on a short weekend.
Transit plan	OMNY/subway planning, walking routes, taxis, and late-night backup affect pacing.
Ticket timing	Broadway, observation decks, museums, events, and timed attractions can drive weekend cost.
Itinerary pacing	A 48-hour trip needs fewer neighborhoods and tighter route grouping than a 72-hour trip.
Hidden fees	Hotel fees, resort/destination fees, taxes, luggage, transfers, service fees, and event fees need a buffer.

2. Weekend Itinerary Paths

Trip type	Best strategy
48-hour highlights	Midtown + Central Park + one skyline view + one Broadway/event block + one neighborhood walk.
72-hour first trip	Add Lower Manhattan/Brooklyn or museum day without overstacking timed tickets.
Couples weekend	Prioritize hotel area, restaurants, skyline, Broadway, and slower neighborhood pacing.
Family weekend	Reduce transfers, avoid late-night logistics, and keep one flexible weather backup.
Budget weekend	Use subway/OMNY, free sights, value hotel areas, and avoid overbuying attraction passes.

3. NYC Weekend Category Matrix

Category	What to check
Flights	Airport, arrival time, baggage, seat fees, late-night transfer risk.
Hotels	Area, fees, taxes, room size, cancellation, walking/subway convenience.
Transfers	JFK/LGA/EWR route, official taxi/ride, public transit, luggage, tolls, traffic.
Transit	OMNY contactless payment, subway/bus route comfort, late-night backup, taxis.
Tickets	Broadway, observation decks, museums, events, passes, timed-entry rules.
Hidden costs	Hotel fees, service fees, luggage storage, bag check, tips, taxes, weather backup.

4. Official-Source Checks

- Use NYC Tourism for borough/neighborhood and official visitor guide links.
- Use MTA/OMNY for subway/bus fare and contactless payment guidance.
- Use Port Authority airport pages for JFK, LaGuardia, Newark, and airport transportation checks.
- Avoid fixed fare, hotel price, Broadway price, and attraction pass claims without a visible last-checked source.
