Always adjust for airline baggage rules, airport security rules, destination weather, medication needs, entry requirements, and your exact itinerary.

1. First 15 Items to Pack

Item	Why it matters	Check
Passport / ID	Flights, hotels, car rentals, and international entry.	
Payment cards + backup	Avoid getting stuck if one card fails.	
Medication + prescriptions	Keep in carry-on with documentation when needed.	
Phone + charger	Boarding passes, maps, bookings, emergency contact.	
Power bank	Useful for delays and long travel days. Check battery rules.	
Travel confirmations	Flights, hotels, transfers, tickets, tours, insurance.	
Insurance details	Policy number, emergency assistance, claim instructions.	
One backup outfit	Protects you if checked luggage is delayed.	
Walking shoes	Essential for city trips and airport connections.	
Weather layer	Rain, cold, AC, and shoulder-season changes.	
Toiletries kit	TSA-size if carry-on only.	
Reusable bottle	Useful after security and on walking days.	
Snacks	Helpful for delays, kids, and tight connections.	
Luggage tag/tracker	Helps identify or locate bags.	
Document copies	Backup for passport, ID, bookings, insurance.	

2. Packing Strategy by Trip Type

Trip type	Packing focus	Avoid
Carry-on only	Compact capsule wardrobe, mini toiletries, one shoe strategy, travel documents.	Bulky extras, large liquids, too many shoes.
International	Passport, adapters, document copies, medication documentation, offline confirmations.	Food/plants/medication without checking customs rules.
Beach	Swimwear, cover-up, sun protection, sandals, wet bag, lightweight layers.	Too many dress outfits or heavy shoes.
City	Walking shoes, layers, compact day bag, weather protection, charger.	Oversized luggage for transit-heavy days.
Cold weather	Base layer, insulating layer, waterproof shell, gloves, warm socks.	Multiple bulky coats when layers work better.
Family	Extra outfit per child, medicine, snacks, entertainment, comfort item.	Packing every item separately instead of shared kits.

3. Gear Features to Compare Before Buying

Gear	Look for	Why
Carry-on bag	Airline-size fit, light weight, durable wheels/handles.	Avoid bag fees and boarding problems.
Personal item	Fits under seat, opens easily, laptop/document pocket.	Keeps travel-day essentials accessible.
Packing cubes	Different sizes, compression only if useful.	Helps organize outfits and reduce overpacking.
Adapter	Destination plug type and USB-C/USB-A needs.	Avoid dead devices on arrival.
Power bank	Airline-compliant capacity and useful ports.	Important for delays and long travel days.
Toiletry bag	Leak control, transparent pouch option, hanging hook.	Keeps liquids organized and contained.

Destination	Pack this	Link idea
Paris	Walking shoes, compact day bag, rain layer, modest outfit, adapter.	/paris-packing-list/
Rome	Modest church clothing, heat protection, walking shoes, anti-theft day bag.	/rome-packing-list/
Tokyo	Comfortable shoes, umbrella, adapter, transit setup, luggage forwarding notes.	/tokyo-packing-list/
NYC	Walking shoes, layers, event outfit, compact bag, seasonal outerwear.	/nyc-packing-list/
Cancun	Swimwear, resort wear, reef-safe sunscreen if needed, wet bag, sandals.	/cancun-packing-list/
Beach trip	Swimwear, sun protection, wet bag, cover-up, sandals.	/beach-vacation-packing-list/
International	Passport, adapters, document copies, medication documentation.	/international-travel-packing-list/
Carry-on only	Capsule wardrobe, mini toiletries, one shoe strategy, laundry plan.	/carry-on-packing-list/

5. Official Rules to Check

- Airline baggage size, weight, and personal-item rules.
- Airport security liquid, aerosol, gel, sharp item, and electronics rules.
- Power bank and lithium battery rules.
- Medication documentation and destination restrictions.
- Customs rules for food, plants, animal products, seeds, and restricted goods.
- Weather and activity-specific packing needs before the final 24-hour check.

5-day clothing capsule	5-day-travel-clothing-capsule.jpg	Five-day travel clothing capsule with mix-and-match tops, bottoms, shoes, and layers.
Toiletry kit	travel-toiletry-kit-carry-on.jpg	Carry-on toiletry kit with small liquids, toothbrush, sunscreen, and medication pouch.

7. Final 24-Hour Packing Check

- Check baggage size/weight and personal-item rules.
- Check weather for every destination and travel day.
- Put passport/ID, medication, documents, chargers, valuables, and insurance details in carry-on.
- Download confirmations, maps, tickets, transfers, and policy details.
- Charge phone, power bank, headphones, watch, and travel devices.
- Remove items that do not match the weather, itinerary, activity, or baggage rules.
